### Calanques National Park

The Calanques National Park, stretching from Marseille to Cassis, is a protected natural treasure known for its spectacular limestone cliffs, crystal-clear coves, and exceptional biodiversity. From the famous En-Vau cove to Sugiton and Morgiou, each site offers breathtaking beauty and a peaceful escape in the heart of nature

As a fragile ecosystem, the park requires special care: visitors are encouraged to stay on marked trails, take their trash with them, and avoid disturbing the wildlife. Protecting this unique environment is essential to preserve its beauty for future generations.



#### **Pavillon Bleu**

The Blue Flag is an international environmental and tourism label awarded annually since 1985 by the Teragir association. It recognizes municipalities and marinas that meet strict criteria in environmental management, sustainable tourism, water quality, safety, and environmental education.

Today, this label is globally recognized as a symbol of coastal quality and environmental responsibility. To earn it, sites must comply with rigorous standards regarding waste management, biodiversity protection, accessibility for all, and public awareness. Near Marseille, several beaches and ports proudly fly the Blue Flag. Among them are Bestouan Beach in Cassis, known for its clear waters and preserved natural environment; Lumière Beach in La Ciotat, which combines water quality and accessibility; and Rouet Beach in Carry-le-Rouet, a family-friendly beach committed to eco-friendly practices.

Even smaller ports, such as the Madrague de Gignac port, have earned this label thanks to their environmentally respectful management.

These examples demonstrate the commitment of coastal communities around Marseille to a cleaner and more sustainable coastline.

#### Sainte-Victoire

The Sainte-Victoire mountain rises majestically over the Aix countryside.

It has inspired many artists, including Paul Cézanne, who depicted it in nearly 80 works. This site is exceptional in many ways. Hiking Sainte-Victoire is a classic Provence experience! Rising to 1,011 meters, this mountain is a symbol of the Bouches-du-Rhône region and its surroundings.

Climb to the Croix de Provence or challenge yourself with the ascent to the Pic de la Mouche!



#### Sources de l'Huveaune

The hike to the Marie-Madeleine cave offers a varied landscape along the banks of the Huveaune River: caves, streams, and forests await you. The walk begins in the center of the village of Nans-les-Pins, near the Chapelle de la Miséricorde.

The hike is 12.5 km long, with an elevation gain between 450 and 700 meters.

## Le Colorado Provençal

Once an open-pit ochre mining site, it is now possible to stroll through a landscape reminiscent of American canyons. You will be instantly captivated by the vivid colors and unique scenery of this place.

# Carry-le-Rouet entre mer et collines

Discover the Côte Bleue through the hills of the Chaîne de l'Estaque on the enchanting route offered by the Blue Train. Let yourself be carried away by the landscape of Marseille from Carry-le-Rouet!

Narrow paths and wide trails lined with rosemary, valerian, kermes oak, and rockrose will delight your senses, along with stunning views of the Mediterranean Sea.

The hike is 12 km long, with an elevation gain of 210 meters. Moderate difficulty level.



#### Sainte-Baume

In the heart of Provence, not far from Aix-en-Provence, the Sainte Baume massif boasts remarkable biodiversity and more. Steeped in the history of Mary Magdalene's retreat after the crucifixion of Jesus Christ, the hikes leading to the summit offer panoramic views stretching to Sainte Victoire, the Alps, and the sea.

The climb to the sanctuary is 3 km, taking about 1 hour of hiking. Moderate difficulty level.

# **MUCEM Program**

The MUCEM, Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilizations, is a major cultural, architectural, and heritage landmark a must-visit in Marseille!

Spread across three sites, it offers a variety of exhibitions.

# Laure Prouvost Exhibition Au Fort — until Sunday, September 28, 2025

Discover the captivating exhibition by Laure Prouvost, titled Au Fort, Les Âmes Sont, held at the MuCEM in Marseille. This exhibition highlights the museum's commitment to contemporary creation and addresses essential issues of our time. Video artist Laure Prouvost presents poetic installations where images transcend screens to interact with visitors through objects, sculptures, and materials. Her dreamlike language evokes surreal imagery and celebrates life and transformation.

# Popular? The Treasures of the MuCEM Collections — until December 31, 2026

For its 10th anniversary, MuCEM showcases its rich and diverse collection, blending folk art and fine art. The permanent exhibition on the ground floor explores the human and historical dimensions of objects, revealing their journey and meaning. Breaking with traditional hierarchies, it juxtaposes paintings, ex-votos, and icons with unexpected pieces such as decorated beehive doors. An immersive digital setup enhances this discovery of the "popular culture" that flows through the museum's identity.

## Field of Visions — until September 16, 2025

Mathilde Rosier's Field of Visions installation adorns the façade of MuCEM's Conservation and Resources Center with about fifty glass eyes, created in collaboration with Cirva. These mysterious growths, halfway between fruits and organs, invite viewers to explore the museum's collections. Sensitive to natural cycles, the artist transforms the wall into a living field where these "seed-eyes" symbolize the growth of knowledge and emotions.

# **Connectivities — Mediterranean Gallery 2, Permanent Exhibition**

A history of the major Mediterranean port cities of the 16th and 17th centuries — Istanbul, Algiers, Venice, Genoa, Seville, and Lisbon — which were then strategic hubs of power and trade.











# Cosquer Méditerranée

Let yourself be amazed by this prehistoric cave discovered by Henri Cosquer, fully recreated inside the Villa Méditerranée building. The Cosquer adventure will reveal all its secrets, hidden for 30,000 years beneath 37 meters of water, as you explore aboard special exploration modules.

# The Musée Regards de Provence

The Musée Regards de Provence highlights two major exhibitions:

"The Public's Choice" (April 4, 2024 to February 15, 2026) showcases visitors' favorite works from the museum's collections, offering a lively and participatory perspective on artistic creation in Provence.

"Laurent Mattio, Painting the Light" (March 25 to September 28, 2025) explores the artist's luminous and poetic universe, capturing Mediterranean landscapes and suspended moments.



# The Museum of Contemporary Art

The Museum of Contemporary Art in Marseille houses a rich collection of modern and contemporary art, rooted in the Nouveaux Réalistes movement and expanded to include Arte Povera, Fluxus, and Supports/Surfaces. It also features digital and video works by artists such as Julien Prévieux and Kader Attia. The museum's garden showcases contemporary sculptures, and the collection is available online through Videomuseum.

# Château Borély - Museum of Decorative Arts, Faience, and Fashion

Château Borély is located in the 8th district of Marseille, near the Corniche and the Prado beaches. Situated in the heart of Parc Borély, the city's most popular green space, with sculptures, ponds, and gardens of all kinds, the majestic 17th-century bastide now houses the Museum of Decorative Arts, Faience, and Fashion.

You can find there a selection of 2,500 works: furniture, ceramics, glassware, tapestries, art objects, rare exotic items, design pieces, and fashion collections from the 18th century to the present day.

Currently, there is an exhibition centered on the color yellow. To showcase collections from Marseille's museums that are rarely displayed to the public, the museum chose this "color of the South" to present 20th-century faience used to beautify everyday tables, alongside haute couture designs imagined by Paco Rabanne, Chantal Thomass, and Christian Lacroix.


